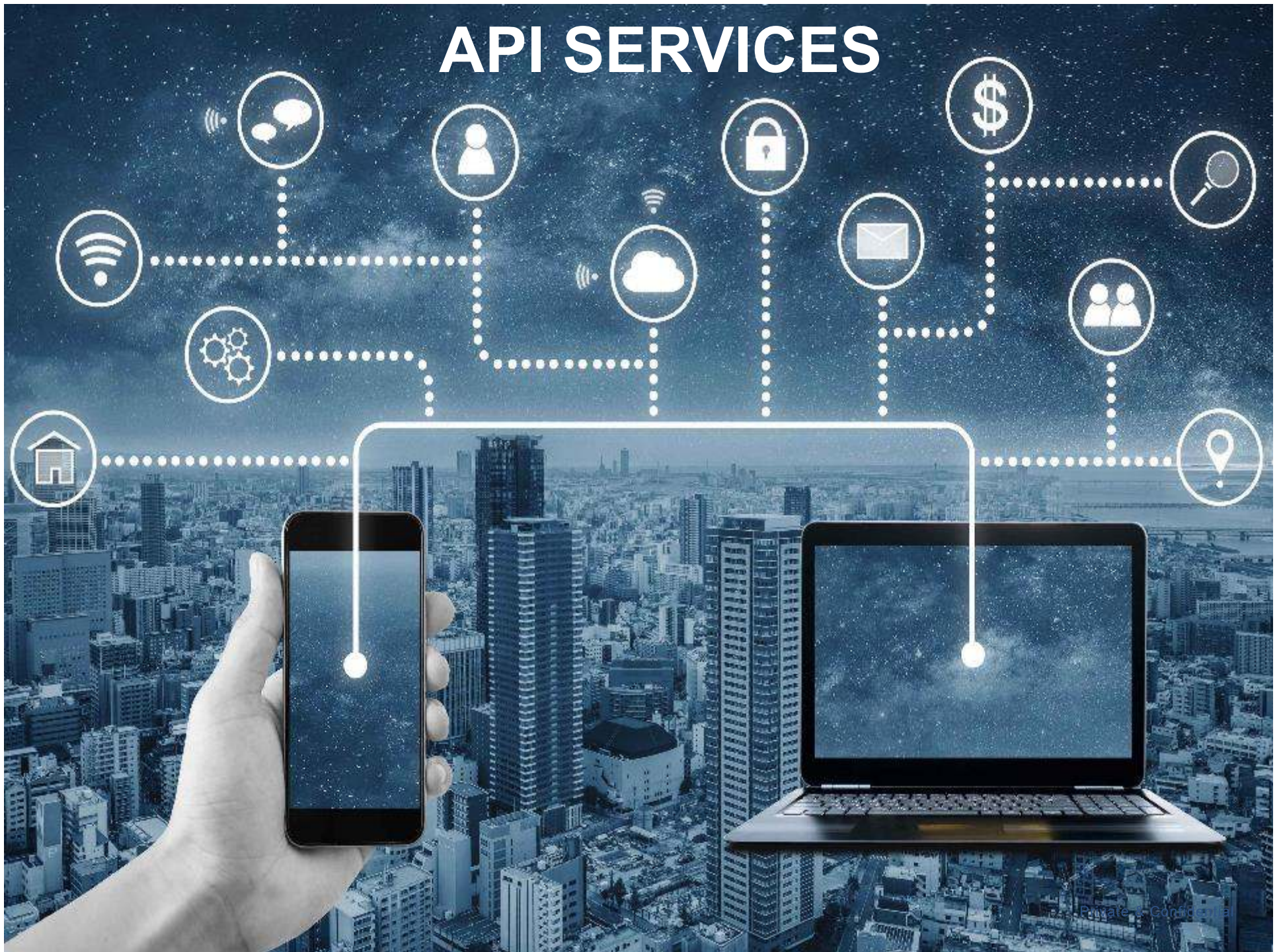

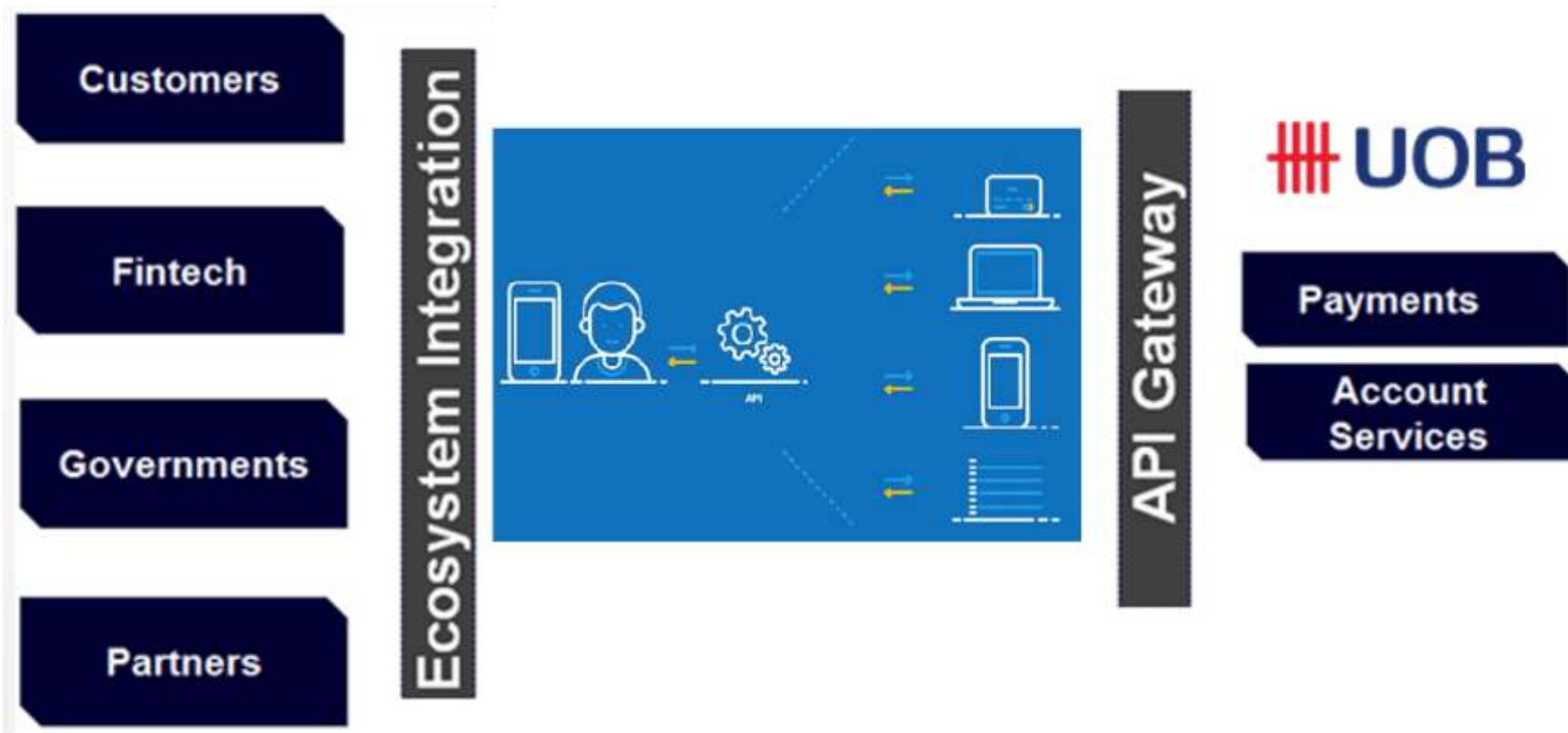


What is API?

APIs as building blocks that can be added to integrate more functions in customer channel

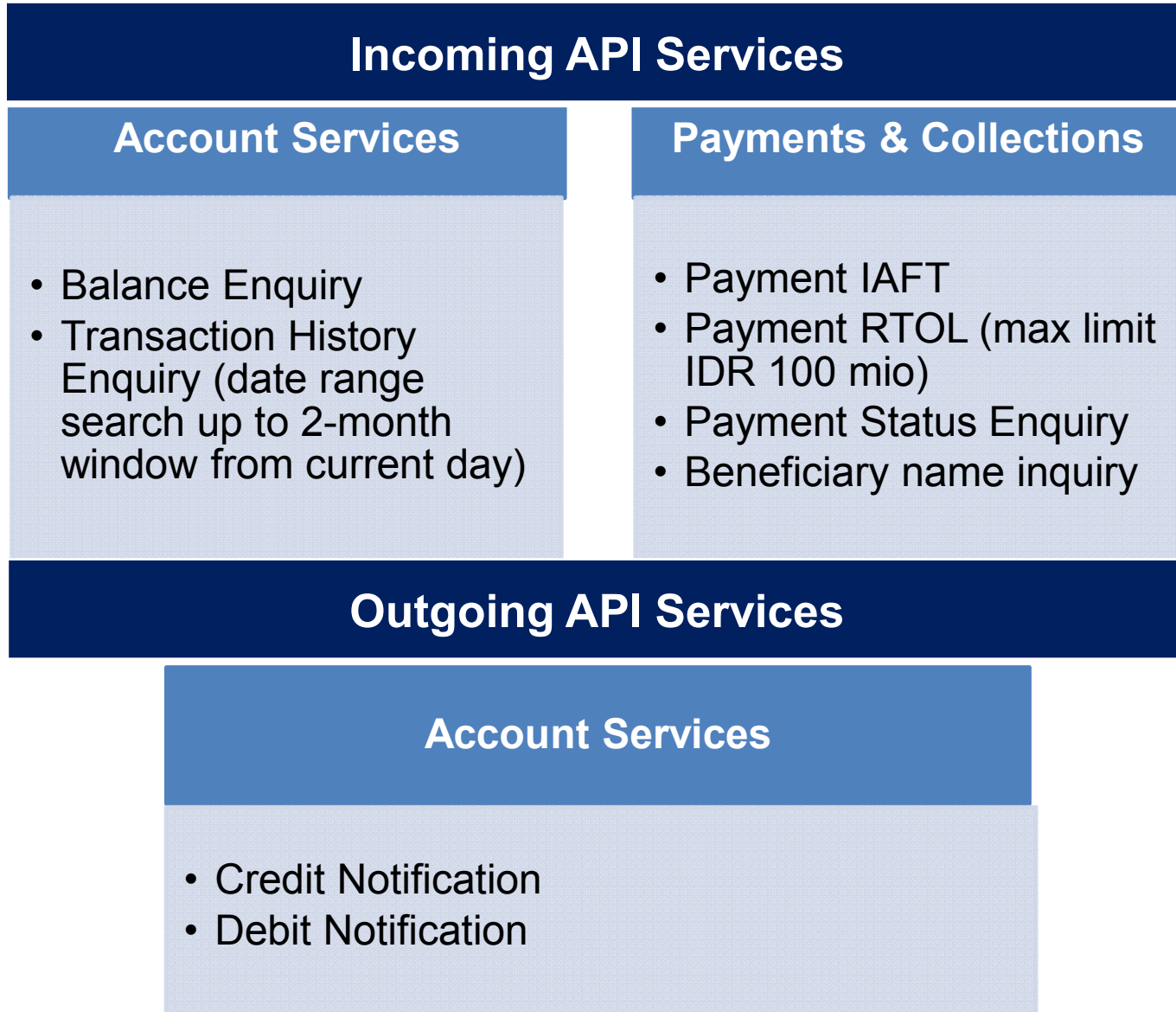


Stakeholders can use API to submit and receive real-time information

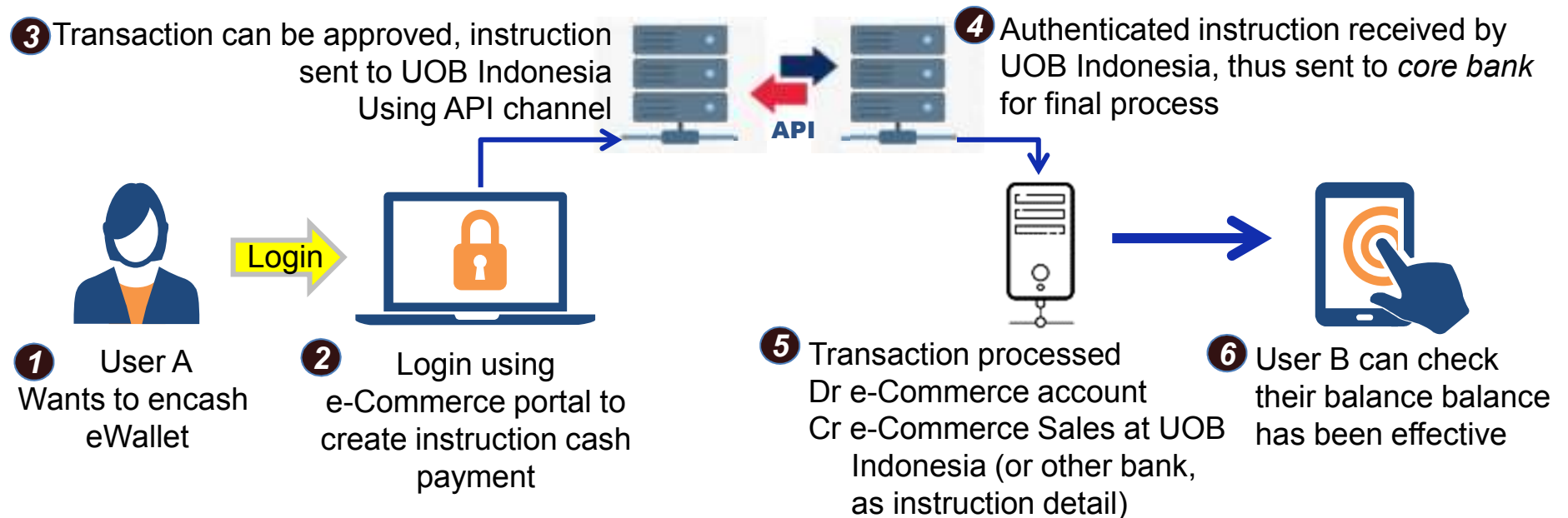

Payment Illustration Real-Time

API payment for transfer to UOB account or RTOL (Real Time Online) – ATM Bersama/ATM Prima

- Useful for company that want payment automation real time
 - example, claim transaction or claim payment
- Payment can be done through transfer to UOB account (IAFT) or RTOL with beneficiary account detail



Features:

- ✓ Daily limit specification (limit cumulative per account)
- ✓ Check payment Status / Transaction history through API
- ✓ Transaction Status will be responded simultaneously
- ✓ RTOL transaction Limit is IDR 100 mio per transfer
